

TYPE – particularly the functional type

TYPE – the functional conformation type of a dog

BREED CHARACTERISTICS – the coat, the shape and colour of eyes, the shape, set and size of ears, tail set and tail carriage. Not included in the type.

GENERAL APPEARANCE – the impression a dog makes as compared to the standard. The type + breed characteristics + the physical and mental condition of a dog.

The theory of cynological typology is made by Olaf Roig from Norway.



Main elements of the functional type:

- Proportions
- Lines
- Size
- Strenght
 - -> Movement




