



BREEDING STRATEGIES


- Systematic and not accidentally, conscious or not conscious, mixture of intuition and rational decision making
- Winning titles or own personal ideal fiction
- Gathering information about individuals
- Evaluating information
- Gathering information about populations
- Accepting suitable dogs and bitches, highly recommending perfectly suitable dogs and bitches, excluding unsuitable dogs and bitches
- Combining mating partners including the coordination of different measures, free decisions, rules, regulations





TYPES OF INFORMATION

- Exterior
- Locomotion and idiomotion including flexibility and motion accompanying characteristics
- Behaviour assessment mainly coping with social stress
- Clinical health data
- Genetic health data
- Need for coordination
- Increases in the amount of information





EXAMPLE: PRAIN THE SLOUGHI

- Monogenic, autosomal, recessive background
- Role of the carriers
- Only very few sick individuals
- Methodological diversity: two different types of reaction
- Other genetic backgrounds

GENOMIC SELECTION AND RELATED METHODS

- We are not talking about cows and the milk market
- Given: tendency or at least risk for a decrease of genetic diversity (popular sires, genetic drift)
- Given: Existence of hereditary diseases and disorders
- Differentiated knowledge about the genom: flood of information, role of information technology
- No self-realization
- Not applicable in the dog world
- Scientific information management and evaluation of test matings, better solutions for the description of genetic diversity
- Faked identities


Programs with phases

PREMIUM CERTIFICATE: THE PRINCIPLE



Proposa

- Positive type of selection instead of contra-selection
- Should be an official act in the FCI
- After the dog has completed the sixth year of life
- Practically and clinically healthy, lively, with sound movement and still excellent quality of life
- Relevance
- Voluntary participation
- Attractive documentation
- Influence on human attention



PREMIUM CERTIFICATE: THE DOCUMENTATION

- Database
- Attractive Publications
- Quality assurance
- Why not information abou every dog?
- Avoiding a bit the problem of secrets



PREMIUM CERTIFICATE: DECISIONS

- No need to breed with very old bitches
- Taking information about relatives of the dog into consideration (but no statistically estimated breeding values)
- Test matings with an analysis of pedigrees
- Role of artificial insemination (dogs with a proofed ability to mate naturally)
- Taking genetic diversity into consideration



RESTRUCTURING CLASSES IN DOG SHOWS



Proposal

- Veteran class for dogs that have completed the ninth year of age
- Premium certification class for dogs that have completed the sixth year of age
- Four CCs under at least three judges in at least three countries (at least one year between the first and the last CC) Premium Champion
- Additional breed specific clinical and genetic charcteristics


